FOOD RESOURCES

Wisconsin FoodShare (Food Stamps or SNAP)

The goal of the Wisconsin FoodShare Program is to end hunger. You can use FoodShare benefits at most stores and many farmers markets.

TEFAP is a federal program that provides food assistance to those with low incomes.
